Vingroup and Masan to cooperate, Masan Consumer aims to become the leading Consumer Goods & Retail Corporation in Vietnam

On 3 December 2019, Vingroup JSC (HOSE: VIC) and Masan Group Corporation (HOSE: MSN) have agreed to proceed with negotiations of binding documents in relation to a potential share swap in relation to VinCommerce and VinEco. The cooperation aims to leverage the operations of the principals and create a premier consumer & retail business in Vietnam. At present, the parties are in the process of conducting further discussions prior to entering into a legally binding agreement.

The parties are proposing to merge VinCommerce Joint Stock Company, Vingroup's retail business, VinEco, Vingroup's agriculture business and Masan Consumer Holdings, Masan's consumer business, to form a consumer and retail company. Vingroup and potentially other minority shareholders will swap shares in VinCommerce into shares of the new company post-transaction. Masan Group will have operational control and Vingroup will continue to be a shareholder.

If the transaction is completed, the new company will have a distribution network of 2,600 VinMart & VinMart+ stores in 50 cities and provinces with millions of customers, 14 high-tech farms of VinEco, and with expertise and resources from 20 years of experience in consumer goods from Masan.

After 5 years of operation, VinCommerce and VinEco has validated Vingroup's mission of building the largest retail platform in Vietnam operating to international standards. VinCommerce has been competing on an equal footing with leading foreign players, and has gained market share for Vietnamese companies. It also supported domestic suppliers to grow through its distribution network.

VinEco also achieved its target of inspiring domestic companies to invest in the high-tech agriculture segment, supporting small-scale agricultural companies to promote clean agriculture, and to ensure the long-term health of the Vietnamese people.

With the desire to bring VinCommerce and VinEco to new heights, and focus resources for our Industrial - Technology segment, Vingroup proposed to cooperate with Masan.
